Companies/Organizations with known accomplishments in Manufacturing, R&D, Product Design & Development, Product or Process Engineering, Product qualification and production support activities, eg;


- · Companies that support development of novel technologies at IIT Delhi

 around a technology idea organisations and companies possessing synergies with the research and development programs
 at IITD and a commitment to strengthen these programs would be preferred. IITD's IPR policy shall be an effective instrument
 of guidance.
